

NTNU Graduate Institute of Art History Japanese Language Proficiency Assessment Examination Implementation Rules

I. The Implementation Rules shall be determined in accordance with Article 3(3) of the *GIAH Eastern Art History Master's Program Course Requirement Guideline*.

II. GIAH office shall serve as the main supervisor of the Institute's Japanese language proficiency assessment test. The test date and application date of the exam shall be consistent with that of the GIAH's qualification examination schedule:

1. Test date: Consistent with qualification examination schedule; to be held in late February, April, late September and November.

2. Application date:

For the first school term (late Sep), candidates shall submit their applications by May 31.

For the first school term (late Nov), and candidates shall submit their applications by October 31.

For the second school term (late Feb), candidates shall submit their applications by November 30.

For the second school term (late Apr), candidates shall submit their applications by March 30.

III. Application Eligibility: Candidates must be GIAH students. There is no semester requirement.

IV. Examination format: Translation (Japanese into Chinese). The pass mark is 70/100.

V. The manner of implementation shall be determined at the GIAH general affairs meeting and implementation shall take place thereafter. The same procedure applies to any amendment
