NTNU GIAH Procedures for Applied Art History Course Certification

Passed at the General Affairs Committee, November 22, 2013

In order to achieve GIAH's educational objectives, to train students to apply their knowledge and boost their competitiveness in the job market, the GIAH has formulated these procedural guidelines.

- Article 1: Students who have completed four applied-related Art History courses and scored no less than 70 for each one may apply.
- Article 2: Applied art history courses offered by GIAH include Techniques and Materials in Western Art, Techniques and Materials in Eastern Art, Museology, Cultural Policies, and Curatorial Practice, as well as fieldwork courses involving historical artifacts and buildings.
- Article 3: The certificates will be standardized and issued by GIAH.
- Article 4: Application schedule: Application backed by academic transcript is to be submitted before May 31 or November 30 of each year.
