Procedure for Awarding Scholarships to Outstanding MA Students Graduate Institute of Art History National Taiwan Normal University

Passed at the General Affairs Committee, June 29, 2009 Passed at the 2015/2016 1st General Affairs Committee, April 11, 2016

- 1. This *Procedure* was drawn up in accordance with the *Procedure for Awarding* Scholarships to Outstanding Master's and PhD Students at the National Taiwan Normal University.
- 2. Expenditure for Graduate Institute of Art History (GIAH) scholarships is budgeted annually by the National Taiwan Normal University (NTNU).
- 3. The GIAH scholarship will be granted every semester to the best student(s), who shall receive a grant and a certificate.
- 4. The GIAH scholarship is only available to second-year MA students. The fall semester scholarship is reserved for students in the Western Art History Program, and the spring semester scholarship is reserved for students in the Oriental Art History Program.
- 5. Candidates for GIAH scholarships are requested to prove that they:
 - (1) Have taken at least two courses and at least six credits in the previous semester (MA thesis not included)
 - (2) Have excellent grades in each course taken and have not failed any course
 - (3) Have obtained an A in moral education
 - (4) Have academic research potential
 - (5) Have not been subsided by other NTNU scholarship (in which case, the GIAH scholarship shall be transferred to the second ranked candidate).
- 6. This *Procedure* for MA student scholarship went into effect after being passed by the GIAH General Affairs Committee. Any future revisions must follow the same procedure.
