## Taiwanese Art History Research Scholarship Regulations, Graduate Institute of Art History, National Taiwan Normal University

Passed at the General Affairs Committee Meeting, September 28, 2020

1. Purpose: This scholarship is used to encourage GIAH students to conduct research on the history of Taiwanese art.

2. Addressees of the award: GIAH graduate students.

3. Quota: Based on the scholarships received each year and the results of the review, up to three candidates can receive the scholarship each year.

4. Scholarship: NT\$50,000 per person (once).

5. Application qualifications and conditions:

5.1 Students of the GIAH have chosen a topic from Taiwanese Art History of their Master's Thesis and passed the Proposal Exam.

5.2 Applicants must fill in the *Taiwanese Art History Research Scholarship Application Form*, including research summary, purpose, for which the scholarship is used, etc. (see attachment).

5.3 Who has been granted the scholarship once cannot re-apply.

6. Application period: Please submit the application form to the GIAH Office at least 1 month after the beginning of the Fall Semester of each academic year for further review.

7. Review committee members and order:

7.1 GIAH full-time faculty members of the Eastern Art History Program who teach Taiwanese Art History may serve as review committee.

7.2 After the review, the result will be announced by the GIAH Office.

8. Who has been granted the scholarship, has to indicate subsequently the source of funding in her/his thesis and in related journal articles, and has to send a copy to the GIAH Office for retention.

9. These regulations have been passed by the General Affairs Committee of the GIAH. They will be submitted for further approval to the President of NTNU and

they will be implemented after the President's approval. Any further revision must follow this same procedure.
